Chapel Endowment Fund

An endowment fund has been established for the chapel to secure it for future generations. The initial amount was funded from a generous donor as well as proceeds from fund raising activities. At some point in the future, the intent is the endowment fund will be able to support on-going chapel operating expenses. Presently the endowment fund has a balance of \$10,000. Our goal for 2007 is to add an additional \$3000 to this important fund. Donations can be directed specifically to the Endowment Fund.

Building Update

A Gazebo is being constructed this summer in the garden area by the chapel.
