## Carry-out Booyah and Bake Sale

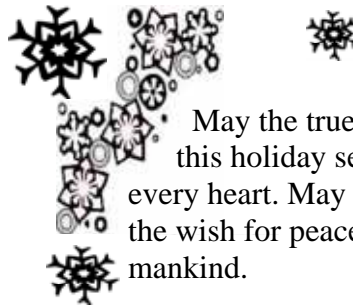
