Year End Donations

As year of 2010 comes to an end, please remember the SSCM chapel as your make your year end donations. The SSCM chapel is a non for profit (501c3) organization. All donations are tax deductible. Included with this Chapel Chatter is an envelope that you can use to make a year end donation or any other donation to the chapel. Remember to make your donation prior to December 31, 2010 to take advantage of the tax deduction this calendar year.

Chapel Endowment Fund

We continue to fund the Chapel endowment as a way to insure the future of the Chapel. Funding is provided from fund raising activities and donations to the endowment fund. The intent of the endowment fund is that it will eventually be able to support on-going chapel operating expenses. The initial projection was that the endowment fund would make the Chapel self-sustaining in 20 years. Currently we are running slightly ahead of



projection due to improving investment returns and donations from individuals for the endowment fund. Additional donations would help accelerate that timeline and are welcome for this important endeavor. Benefactor's Walk

A Benefactor's Walk will be built in the garden area that will have an engraved plaque with the individual's name that have contributed to this fund. There will be levels as follows:

- Gold level is \$1,500 or more,
- Bronze level is \$1,499 - \$1,000 and
- Silver level is \$999 - \$500.
